IMPLEMENTING AND MANAGING CARBON OFFSETTING AND REDUCTION SCHEME FOR INTERNATIONAL AVIATION (CORSA)

1. PURPOSE

This course will provide managers at environment department in their aviation field with the necessary knowledge, skills and attitudes to ensure that aviation environment is managed appropriately in accordance with relevant international regulations and recent trends in the field.

2. CONTENTS

- Climate change response system of international aviation and outline of CORSA
- Exercising calculation of CO2 offsetting requirements for operator
- Role of ICAO, State, aircraft operator, and verification body in CORSA
- Eligible emissions units for CORSA and transaction of emissions units
- Visiting airlines of Korea to observe their monitoring and managing system for CORSA

4. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

- At least three (3) years of experience in the aviation environment
- Be in good health both physically and mentally, to undergo the course
- Sufficient proficiency in spoken English
- Not participated in the ROK – ICAO fellowship training programme during the past three (3) years.
- Should submit the Official Nomination Form issued and authorized by applicant's Government

5. EXPENSES

- The Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport in the ROK will bear expenses including course fees, accommodation fees and some living expenses such as daily allowance, meals, etc.
- Airfare and travel allowance for the participation for this course shall be paid by the participant's side.

6. PROCESS OF APPLICATION AND SELECTION

- a) Access the registration menu on the website (*www.korea-ftp.org*) with your e-mail address and password.
- b) Complete the application and upload the official nomination at the same time.
- c) Submit your medical report through the website after getting the medical requirement from the Korean Government.

- d) Applicant will get the award from ICAO according to the result of Korean Selection Committee.
- e) Incheon Airport Aviation Academy will contact the participants regarding invitation letter, visa and travel arrangements.

Remarks: — *Selections will be made by the Selection Committee in the Republic of Korea after the details on your application and official nomination registered in the website are confirmed by Korean Government Official.*
