1. BACKGROUND

This programme is designed to assist the Member States in preparing for USOAP CMA in an efficient manner by helping them better manage ICAO SARPs and USOAP CMA Protocol Questions through SARPs Management and Implementation System (SMIS) and SOMS (Safety Oversight Management System) developed by the Republic of Korea.

2. PURPOSE

This course is organized by bridging theory on USOAP CMA and practical exercise utilizing the electronic safety tools developed by the ROK in improving the State's safety for the management capabilities.

7. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of three years' of ICAO USOAP and/or safety management and oversight experience;
- Must be in good physical and mental health;
- Proficient in spoken English;
- Did not participate in the ROK – ICAO fellowship training programme within the last three years;
- Submission of Official Nomination Form duly authorized by applicants' Government.

8. EXPENSES

- Incheon Airport Aviation Academy (IAAA) will bear expenses including course fees, accommodation fees, meals and daily allowance.
- Airfare and travel allowance for the participation in this course shall be paid by the participant's side.

9. PROCESSING OF APPLICATION AND SELECTION

- a) Access the registration menu on the website (*www.korea-ftp.org*) with your e-mail address and password.
- b) Complete the application and upload the official nomination.
- c) Submit your medical report through the website after obtaining the medical requirement from the Korean Government.
- d) Applicant will receive the award from ICAO according to the results from the Korean Selection Committee.
- e) Course Coordinator will contact the participants regarding invitation letter and transportation to the training venue, etc.
